Temperature differences with Tokyo are approximately 10°C.

Temperatures plummet below zero during winter in Hokkaido. It is especially cold in January and February, and differences in temperature between Tokyo and Sapporo are approximately 10°C. Please dress warm so as not to catch cold.

How to Dress for Winter

Since there is a significant difference in indoor and outdoor temperatures, we recommend that you wear layers of heat-retaining inner wear, a light, warm down jacket and so forth. A cap, gloves and a muffler are also necessary.



No problem with snowy streets with slip stoppers!

Some streets are very slippery. People who are not used to snow are kindly advised to buy winter shoes or slip stoppers that readily attach to their shoes to prevent slips, falls and injuries. Slip stoppers are available at airport shops, convenience stores and the like.
